

- Step 1: Remove banjo bolt on caliper.
- Step 2: Remove hard line from brake line at frame.
- Step 3: Remove brake line retaining clip.
- Step 4: Remove old brake line.
- Step 5: Install new extended brake line at frame with new retaining clip.
- Step 6: Connect hard line to new extended brake line and tighten nut.
- Step 7: Connect extended brake line at caliper using banjo bolt and new washers.
- Step 8: Tighten banjo bolt.
- Step 9: Repeat steps 1 through 8 on other side.
- Step 10: Bleed brake lines using bleeder valve on the calipers.
- Step 11: Top off brake fluid.
- Step 12: Start vehicle and apply brakes.
- Step 13: Check for leaks.
