

- Step 1: Install part number COR-2106110 3 piece cross member.
- Step 2: Install part number COR-2206110 rear frame brackets.
- Step 3: Install part number COR-2206210 uni-body frame rails.
- Step 4: Chock front and back of the driver side front wheel.
- Step 5: Remove upper and lower control arms.
- Step 6: Remove lower control arm bracket on frame side.
- Step 7: Install driver side arm of part number COR-1906100 lower control arm.
- Step 8: Install the dog legged arm of part number COR-1900011 upper control arm.
- Step 9: Repeat steps 4 to 8 on the passenger side.
- Step 10: Install part number COR-4506200 adjustable front track bar.
- Step 11: Install part number COR-1506450 front coil springs.
- Step 12: Install shocks.
- Step 13: Chock front and back of both rear wheels.
- Step 14: Support axle to maintain pinion angle.
- Step 15: Remove upper control arm and arm ball joint.
- Step 16: Install part number COR-1206010 axle truss or COR-1206100 4-link bracket.
- Step 17: Remove one lower control arm.
- Step 18: Remove lower control arm bracket on frame side.
- Step 19: Install one of part number COR-1906101 lower control arm.
- Step 20: Repeat steps 14 to 16 on opposite side.
- Step 21: Install part number COR-1900102 rear upper control arms.
- Step 22: Install part number COR-1506451 rear coil springs.
- Step 23: Install shocks.

Notes: All final adjustments and tightening of hardware should be done with the vehicle sitting at ride height. Care should be taken to set caster and track without binding up the suspension.






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

- Step 2: Support vehicle drive line.
- Step 3: Remove old cross member.
- Step 4: Trim flange off from rocker panel.
- Step 5: Clean frame for welding.
- Step 6: Lightly bolt new cross member into place.
- Step 7: Square and center cross member.
- Step 8: Tighten bolts.
- Step 9: Weld both sides along the front, back & end.
- Step 10: Bolt transmission mount with new hardware.
- Step 11: Weld end caps on with access holes aligned.
- Step 12: Paint cross member.





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

- Step 1: Install part number COR-2106110 3 piece cross member.
- Step 2: Clean frame for welding.
- Step 3: Locate brackets according to dimensions given. Wood blocks and a bottle jack work well for holding the brackets in place.
- Step 4: Check fitment of WJ uni-body sub frame rails. Leaving about 1/8" gap is helpful during the install.
- Step 5: Tack weld 4 corners of brackets.
- Step 6: Weld around all 4 sides of the bracket.
- Step 7: Weld end caps on with access holes aligned.
- Step 8: Paint frame brackets.


Note: It is possible to use these brackets without part number COR-2106110 and measure from the stock cross member. We recommend using part number COR-2206210 to reinforce the brackets.









- Step 1: Install part number COR-2106110 3 piece cross member.
- Step 2: Install part number COR-2206110 rear frame brackets.
- Step 1: Clean frame for welding.
- Step 2: Locate rails according to dimensions given. Wood blocks and a bottle jack work well for holding the rails in place.
- Step 3: Check fitment with WJ 1/4" transfer case skid plate if using.
- Step 4: Tack weld 4 corners of rails.
- Step 5: Weld around 3 sides of the end of the rails.
- Step 6: Weld along the insides and outside of the rails. Min. 6 welds spaced out.
- Step 6: Paint sub frame rails.

Note: These frame rails can be installed alone but will interfere with installing other parts of our system in the future.


- Step 1: Support axle from pivoting on lower control arms. (A bottle jack works well)
- Step 2: Remove old upper control arms.
- Step 3: Make sure vehicle is at ride height and track is set.
- Step 4: Install new upper control arm at axle using new hardware.
- Step 5: Adjust caster angle to specifications below.
- Step 6: Adjust both arm length to get the bolts in on the control arm mount with grease fitting up.
- Step 7: Tighten bolts.
- Step 8: Tighten jam nuts. (We recommend a 1 7/16" combination wrench for this. We also recommend cutting the box end off the wrench and getting a three foot pieces pipe to put over the end of the wrench for leverage. Inserting a large screw driver between the joint body and the mount will hold the housing joint straight.)

Step 9: The joints are pre greased so initial greasing is not required. (We do recommend greasing the joints every time you change your oils or grease other components on your vehicle. Use a hand grease gun not a pneumatic grease gun.

We recommend a caster angle on the drivers side to be between 5 and 6 degrees. (Top of the inner knuckle tipped towards the rear of the vehicle) In certain cases caster angles as low as 3 to 4 degrees are possible to get better drive shaft angles however this may effect the handling of the vehicle. Too much caster change from the factory settings may also cause the coil springs to bow and effect clearances on the steering linkages. Keep length within the minimum and maximum lengths shown below.








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

- Step 1: Remove old track bar.
- Step 2: Using a 6 point 18mm comb. wrench snap old track bar mount nut off axle.
- Step 3: Drill track bar mount on frame to 9/16" diameter.
- Step 4: Drill track bar mount on axle to 9/16" diameter.
- Step 5: Center the body of the vehicle over the axle.
- Step 6: Measure from bolt hole to bolt hole.
- Step 7: Adjust track bar to length. Approximate length is 33.125" for 4" to 6" of lift.
- Step 8: Install track bar.
- Step 9: Tighten both bolts and jam nut.





Step 11: Weld in keyways as indicated.

Step 12: Weld truss ends to axle tube on the inside.

Step 13: Remove bolts from truss.

Step 14: Align upper mounts with marks.



- Step 1: Set both arms as close to recommended length as possible with grease fittings lined up.
- Step 2: Set desired pinion angle. (1 to 2 degrees down is recommended for CV style drive shafts, a bottle jack works well for this.)
- Step 3: Center chassis over axle. (Ratchet straps work well for this.)
- Step 4: Install one arm at frame end with grease fittings up.
- Step 5: Adjust the length of the arms so that you can easily get the bolt in at the axle end with the grease fitting up.
- Step 6: The center ball of the Johnny Joint may need to be aligned for the bolt to get the bolt to go in easily.
- Step 7: Repeat steps 4 and 6 on other side.
- Step 8: Tighten bolts after vehicle is sitting at ride height.
- Step 9: Tighten jam nuts. (We recommend a 1 7/16" combination wrench for this. We also recommend cutting the box end off the wrench and getting a three foot pieces pipe to put over the end of the wrench for leverage. Inserting a large screw driver between the joint body and the mount will hold the housing joint straight.)
