
## Clayton Off Road COR-4109010 Jeep Wrangler Front Axle Disconnect Skid Plate (2018+, JL)

- Step 1: Install part number COR-5209011 Jeep Wrangler Steering Stabilizer Relocation Bracket Kit (2018 & Up, JL).
- Step 2: Remove old front axle disconnect skid plate.
- Step 3: Slide new front axle disconnect skid plate into position on axle.
- Step 4: Install two supplied flat head screws in the bottom of the skid plate.
- Step 5: Install two upper rear factory bolts on the skid plate.
- Step 6: Install two upper front factory bolts in the skid plate.
- Step 7: Tighten two flat head screws first.
- Step 8: Tighten remaining four factory bolts.
- Step 9: Use supplied wire tie to secure wire to disconnect motor.
